## God's Body Armor

## The Realm of Salvation

#### The Realm of Darkness

Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. 2 Corinthians 4:4

#### The Realm of Salvation

He has rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son He loves. Colossians 1:13 (HCSB)

# Getting Your Head into Salvation

A warrior puts on the helmet for battle. It is not a soft pillow for relaxing or contemplating but for action. Everything is turned on and tuned up. Sight, hearing, all the senses are activated. The helmet protects the head, the control center, the place where what is seen and heard is evaluated immediately and responded to.

Salvation is protection of the central processing center of the brain. What if a person has a weak or faulty concept of salvation, how effective is that helmet of salvation against a determined enemy?

What if a person does not see things God's way?

What if salvation is something you do in church to make sure you go to heaven when you die, how can you stand firm against the power of the devil?

Having the helmet of salvation requires a new way of thinking, God's way of thinking.

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect. Romans 12:2 (NLT2)

The helmet of salvation is not just an idea, it is a necessary piece of equipment that defines God's warrior in the battle of the ages.

# Salvation in Your Battle with the Devil

Salvation redefines you. Salvation makes you a child of God, a redeemed person, someone made new in Christ, no longer under the realm of the devil.

Satan will come as he did with Jesus and say, "if you are a child of God, then..." He will push and shove you and try to trick you into denying who you are. The helmet of salvation defines you.

Be sure of your salvation. Be able to identify who you are in Christ. Know what you believe, not just what you profess. Your salvation determines your destination now and forever.
